# Saint Ansgar Elementary School \*Requirements for Kindergarten\*

The following items must be submitted to the office on conferences the day before your child's first day of school.

## \*COPY OF BIRTH CERTIFICATE or copy of hospital record of birth

#### \*PHYSICAL EXAM

Please include medications, allergies and any other pertinent health information.

### \*PROOF OF VALID IMMUNIZATIONS

- A 5<sup>th</sup> dose of DTaP is required --- one dose after age 4
- A fourth dose of Polio is required --- one dose after age 4
- 2 doses of MMR --- the first dose must have been received on or after 12 months of age; the second dose shall have been received no less than 30 days after the first dose.
- Proof of 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine.
- Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine --- A second dose of Varicella is required unless there is a reliable history of natural disease.
- (If your child is up to date with their immunizations, they will only need their 5 year-old shots, which generally consists of 5<sup>th</sup> DTaP, 4<sup>th</sup> Polio, 2<sup>nd</sup> MMR, & 2<sup>nd</sup> Varicella.)

**\*Student Health Update Form**- You will only complete this one time and it will follow your child through graduation. \*Please note, this form is different than the health form required for Pre-School students.

**\*VISION-** The state of Iowa requires we submit record of vision screening on each Kindergarten student. *Please bring a completed green "Student Vision Card" after you have visited the eye Dr.*, **OR** *complete the consent to have your child screened by the Iowa Kidsight program offered through our local Lions Club.* 

## \*PROOF OF DENTAL EXAMINATION

An Iowa Department of Public Health Certificate of Dental Screening is to be completed. **\*\***<u>Only for Kindergarten students</u>. NOT needed for Pre-K students.

**\*BLOOD LEAD TESTING** if never done in the past. If the Iowa Department of Public Health has a record of the test, your child does not need another test.
